Target Group

This appraisal program is designed for any/all personnel involved in the planning, coordination or umpiring of Emergency Drills and Exercises in the Offshore Oil & Gas Industry.

Course Objectives

Drills and exercises provide a company with an opportunity to validate their organisations capability to respond or manage an emergency situation. The frequency in which we conduct Drills and Exercises varies greatly from company to company however one element remains critical to the value obtained from any drill; ARE THEY BEING CONDUCTED AS EFFECTIVELY AS THEY CAN BE?

This program is designed to provide the Coordinators of these drills with the confidence, skills, tools and understanding of what is needed to ensure a drills effectiveness such as;

- Planning
- Briefing
- Coordinating
- Umpiring
- Debriefing; and,
- Reporting

Course Outline

The program involves a combination of Theory and Practical Scenarios designed to build confidence and provide the Drill Coordinators with the best platform from which to enable them to return to their facilities and ensure that maximum value is extracted from every drill. This program should give both the facility Manager and HSE Departments the peace of mind that drills are not simply being 'conducted' but the personnel involved are in a continual learning and development building process that extends beyond a drills conduct. The concept of 'Mini Drills' is also a key element in achieving this and is covered on course.
