Course Outline

Exercise Scenarios for the assessment will be taken from the following generic list:

- Environmental Incident
- Explosion and Fire
- Common Areas Fire
- Mobile Asset Incident
- Terrorist Incident
- Civil Incident
- Structural Collapse
- Natural Disaster
- Loss of Stability

Each of the exercises will have a level of difficulty, assessors will observe the exercises and gather raw evidence on the candidate's performance, this evidence will then be converted into specific comments, recommendation and ratings against each performance criteria, and the exercise as a whole.

Course Duration

2 Days

Pre-requisite & Structure

The delegates attending this course should have completed the WGGOA Major Emergency Management Appraisal course prior to this formal assessment.

The practical, role play assessment is customized to meet the delegates company & industry criteria and expected responses by the person in charge of leading, an Emergency Response, activities to an incident at their workplace.

All outcomes are to be in-line with the principles of the US based Incident Command System techniques and philosophies.
